Summary and Farewell

The International Mendel Day

On February 8 and March 8, 1865, Gregor Mendel delivered two lectures at the Natural Science

Society meetings in Brno outlining the results of his "Experiments in Plant Hybrids". In order to

commemorate that landmark event in the history of genetics, the Czech Mendel museum

Mendelianum (Moravian Museum, Brno) has initiated an International Mendel Day to be

celebrated on March 8 each year. The calendar location of Mendel Day in March is right in

between Darwin Day (February) and DNA Day (April) which further emphasizes Gregor Mendel

as the symbolic link between traditional and modern science. Thus, International Mendel Day

has developed into an occasion not only to bring Gregor Mendel and history of science back on

stage, but to focus on the importance of modern genetic research to medicine, biology and

agricultural sciences as well.

Since 2015, International Mendel Day events including lectures, symposia and other public

activities have been organized in Brno / Czech Republic, Tucson, AZ/USA, Orem, UT/USA, Tokyo

/ Japan, Sidney / Australia, London / UK and Vienna / Austria. In 2017, the International Mendel

day was held at Brno, and a walk on Mendel's path was undertaken in Vienna. In 2018, the

major event took place in Brno, whereas in 2019 the International Mendel Day was organized

in collaboration with the Society of Genetics at the Royal Institution, London.
